



Per Governor Hogan's Executive Order and following the guidelines from the CDC, WHO, and other local and national health organization, we have listed a summary below as well as a very detailed attachment of the following protocol and procedures to as they pertain to Phase II of our reopening:

The Club leadership and management cannot stress enough the importance of reading, understanding, and following these protocols. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask for clarification.

- Guests are permitted Monday-Sunday (Guests are permitted Saturday & Sunday after 11:00am; however, priority will be given to member-only foursomes when the lottery is being processed)
- Members and guests must wear a mask anytime they are indoors at the Club and are responsible for providing their own mask
- Physical distancing (staying at least six feet from one another at all times) must be practiced
- Outdoor Practice Facilities are open for use (physical distancing is required)
- The Bag Room will be available for club storage and club cleaning. Staff members will be implementing sanitizing procedures for the handling and cleaning of member clubs and golf bags
- Some amenities will not be available at this time due to sanitizing challenges
- The Loft is open
- Private lessons will be available and will adhere to physical distancing guidelines
- Tee times will be scheduled every 12 minutes rather than 10 minutes on both the East and West Courses
- Weekend lotteries will take place
- Tee times may be made up to one week in advance either by phone or online
- As of Saturday, June 13, two people will be permitted to ride together in a golf car without a facial cloth covering if they live in the same household. If two people who do NOT live in the same household are sharing a cart, a facial cloth covering is required
- Each golf car will be sanitized prior to and following each use including divot bottles
- BCC push carts will be available and will be sanitized prior to and following each use
- There will be no ball washers, ball retrievers, or bunker rakes
- Flagsticks need to stay in and must not be touched
- In order to reduce cart traffic on our courses, we strongly recommend the use of a caddie. If you would like to request a caddie, please contact Caddie Manager Jason Hernandez at [jhernandez@bcc1898.com](mailto:jhernandez@bcc1898.com)
- Caddies will be available based upon requests. The interaction between player and caddie will be done in accordance with all social distancing guidelines (no exceptions)
- The Golf House is open Monday-Friday from 7:00am-7:00pm and Saturday & Sunday from 6:00am-7:00pm. Only five members will be allowed in the Golf Pro Shop at once
- Sign-in at the Golf House will no longer take place at this time (tee managers will be responsible for checking you in for play)
- Towels will be provided beginning Saturday, June 20. As an extra preventative measure, a machine has been added to our towel sanitization process that dispenses antiviral detergent
- Water coolers on the course are unavailable. Bottled water will be available in coolers at the rain shelters on the course (please sanitize your hands prior to reaching into the cooler)
- The refreshment stands are open
