Squash COVID-19 Guidelines

- **Masks must be worn properly (covering nose and mouth) inside the Roland Park facility and on the squash courts at all times**
- Hours of Operation: Monday–Saturday, 6:30am–7:15pm
- Hand sanitizer **MUST** be used before and after play and before entering the Pro Shop
- Hand sanitizer will be placed on the blue counter at the bottom of the steps when entering or exiting squash courts and in the Squash Pro Shop
- Doubles will be open to normal play
- Singles play - Two players on the court maximum to play. Players can be from different households
- Private and semi private lessons only; no clinics
- Goggles and racquets **MUST** remain on the floor, not leaned against walls
- Players are encouraged to wear headbands and wristbands. Hands **MUST NOT** be wiped on the walls
- Players are encouraged to bring a change of shirt to limit the amount of sweat that may drop on courts
- No demo racquets or borrowed glasses at this time
- Towels are available. Dirty towels must be left in the towel bin at the entrance to the squash courts
- Please bring your own water. Water is not available at this time
- The upstairs viewing area is open

Locker Rooms

- Laundry service is not available at this time
- Showers are available
- Towels are available

Squash Dress Code

Access at Roland Park

In order to maintain a pleasant dining experience for all members and guests, it is requested that individuals intending to use Squash, Fitness, or Paddle facilities access these facilities through the athletic entrance. The athletic entrance is located between the Grille and fitness hallway off the patio. Blue denim and athletic shoes are only permitted when directly entering and exiting the locker rooms through the athletic entrances.

Squash Attire

Attire must be predominately (at least 85%) white. White gym shorts, lacrosse shorts, and collared or performance crew neck shirts. Some colored trim or logos on all white attire is acceptable. Non-marking or gum rubber-soled shoes. Squash players must adhere to the Club's posted dress code when entering the Clubhouse or using the Club's other facilities. Squash attire may be worn in the Squash areas, on the Grille Porch, and in the Maryland Room only. Squash players dressed in Squash attire must use the athletic entrance only.

Electronic Device Policy

All electronic device usage must be brief, discreet, and respectful and not impede the enjoyment of the Club by other members or guests.

Electronic Device Definition: Cell phones, smartphones, tablets, earbuds, watches, laptops, and similar devices

- Phone calls or video conferences of any kind are prohibited on Club property except in private meeting rooms, locker rooms, restrooms, and inside personal vehicles
- Electronic devices, while discouraged, may be used for non-verbal activity (includes texting) throughout the Club, golf courses, and Practice Facilities on silent or vibrate mode only
- Laptop use is only permitted in the Card Room at Five Farms or the Maryland Room at Roland Park and is not required to be brief. Tablet use is only permitted inside the Pool Complex, the Card Room, and the Maryland Room and is not required to be brief
- When devices are not in use, they must be kept out of view
- No pictures or videos of any kind are permitted to be taken in any restroom, changing area or locker room at any time. Photos or videos in the Fitness Center for use as part of a routine or work out are permitted only when the individual(s) being filmed or photographed have provided their permission. Any violation of this portion of the Electronic Device Policy will result in a formal disciplinary action, including the possibility of suspension or expulsion from membership

It is the member's responsibility to monitor and regulate their guest's and child/children's electronic device usage in accordance with this policy. For your convenience, courtesy phones are located throughout the Club on both campuses and the Pool Complex.

A member or guest in violation of the Electronic Device Policy will be asked to comply immediately. A violation of the Electronic Device Policy above may result in a meeting with the Traditions and Membership Experience Committee and could result in a suspension or a fine up to \$500.
